DEFENDING THE CONSTITUTION & OUR TRADITIONAL AMERICAN VALUES

- ✓ Fought to defend TX-19 constituents and servicemembers from unconstitutional vaccine mandates.
- ✓ Defended the 2nd Amendment by sponsoring the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act and opposing red flag laws, gun registries, and universal background checks.
- ✓ Promoted election integrity by sponsoring legislation to require voter ID while protecting states' rights.
- ✓ Fought to protect the unborn by sponsoring pro-life legislation, including the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act and the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act, and celebrated the SCOTUS decision to overturn Roe v. Wade.
- ✓ Fought to keep biological males out of female college athletics.

STRENGTHENING OUR SECURITY & RESTORING LAW & ORDER

- ✓ Secured critical funding for modernizing the B-1 and the development of the B-21 at Dyess AFB.
- ✓ Led over 65 Members from 26 states in legislation to recognize states' sovereign right to secure their borders and protect their citizens.
- ✓ Championed legislation to prohibit taxpayer dollars from flowing to illegal immigrants and sanctuary states.
- ✓ Sponsored legislation to prevent China from purchasing US farmland, especially around military installations.

CHAMPIONING RURAL AMERICA & AMERICAN ENERGY INDEPENDENCE

- ✓ Passed Ports to Plains legislation, signing into law I-27 as a federal highway designation.
- ✓ Championed several pieces of legislation to ensure access to healthcare for West Texans, repeal burdensome mandates on rural hospitals, and increase price transparency.
- ✓ Fought the Administration's punitive policies on domestic oil & gas production.
- ✓ Led House passage of legislation to ban Russian oil and supported efforts to prohibit the President from depleting our Strategic Petroleum Reserves.
- ✓ Advocated for temporary disaster relief for farmers experiencing unprecedented challenges, including historic drought conditions, record input costs, supply chain disruptions, and labor shortages.

REINING IN THE GOVERNMENT & HOLDING CONGRESS ACCOUNTABLE

- ✓ Demanded fiscal accountability by introducing legislation to balance the federal budget and reform our Congressional budget process.
- ✓ Introduced a resolution calling for a Convention of the States to propose a fiscal responsibility amendment to the U.S. Constitution.
- ✓ Authored legislation to repeal Biden's "Made in America" tax policy on domestic manufacturers and energy producers.
- ✓ Fought back against unconstitutional executive actions on welfare expansion, eviction moratoriums, and student loan bailouts.
