3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Telehealth Expansion  
5 Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. MAKING PERMANENT THE SAFE HARBOR FOR AB-**  
2 **SENCE OF DEDUCTIBLE FOR TELEHEALTH.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 223(c)(2)(E) of the Inter-  
4 nal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “In the  
5 case of” and all that follows through “a plan” and insert-  
6 ing “A plan”.

7 (b) **CERTAIN COVERAGE DISREGARDED.**—Section  
8 223(c)(1)(B)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is  
9 amended by striking “(in the case of months or plan years  
10 to which paragraph (2)(E) applies)”.

11 (c) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
12 this subsection shall apply to plan years beginning after  
13 December 31, 2024.
