## A BILL

- To amend the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act to provide for improved coordination between the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency and the Secretary of Agriculture, and for other purposes.

11	imposed by this subsection may be waived or modi-
12	fied for a specific action to the extent agreed upon
13	by the Administrator, the Secretary of Agriculture,
14	and the registrant so long as such agreement is pub-
15	lished by the Administrator in the docket for the
16	corresponding action.".
